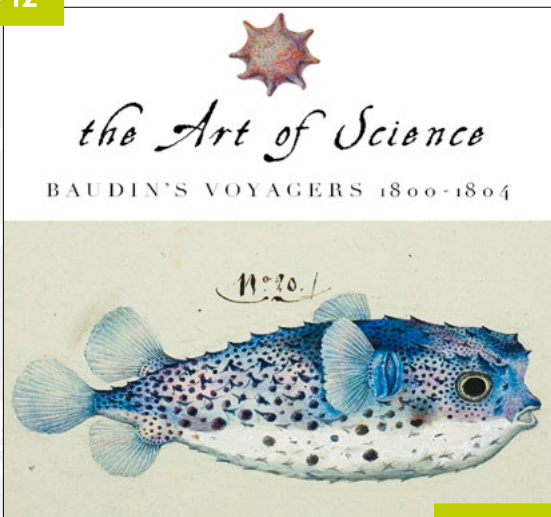

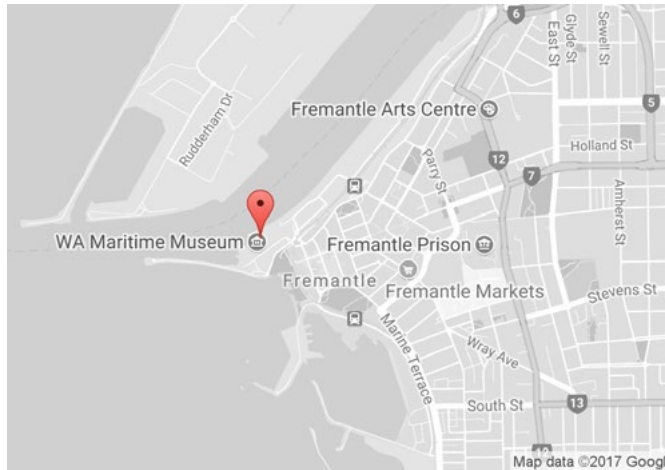

Immigration: Suitcase Stories
