



Submarine HMAS *Ovens* Tour Conditions of Entry

Please read the following guidelines carefully before booking a HMAS *Ovens* submarine tour. These guidelines outline the physical requirements and conditions of entry, ensuring the safety and comfort of all participants.

Conditions of Entry:

- A reasonable fitness level is required to undertake a tour
- Participants must be a minimum of five years or older and a minimum of 100 cm in height.
- Participants between the ages of five and 16 years must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- Flat shoes with enclosed toes are recommended. High heels are not permitted.
- The submarine is not accessible by wheel chairs, walking aids, prams and baby carriers
- Backpacks and/or large handheld items are not permitted on the vessel. Lockers are available for hire to secure these items, please enquire at the front desk.
- Food and drink are NOT permitted on the vessel.
- There are no toilet facilities available on the vessel
- A maximum of ten participants per tour group; inclusive of required supervisors (if applicable).
- The Museum reserves the right to refuse entry.

The Museum acknowledges that sometimes there are exceptional circumstances when the above guidelines may be varied at the Museum's discretion.

The Submarine tour experience requires climbing, crouching and navigating in confined spaces, including:



Walking up and down three flights of stairs (nine metres high).



Climbing up and down steeply inclined ladders, all of which have guiding handrails.



Bending through narrow hatchways and low lying areas. Stepping over bulkheads and manoeuvring through confined spaces.
