

## Wild About Wetlands Facilitated Program

**Overview:** Help us monitor the health of Perth's wetlands with a *Biodiversity Backpack* full of cool science equipment. Test the water quality, inspect the flora and fauna and discover how you can help your local wetlands. These interactive kits will enable students to explore the various elements that contribute to a healthy wetland ecosystem and consider what puts them at risk.

**Duration:** One hour facilitated experience, including exploration of the Perth Cultural Centre's Wetlands using the *Biodiversity Backpack* kit.

Please allow approximately 45 minutes additional time for self-guided gallery exploration in the Museum, using the Student Activity sheets.

### What your class will experience:

- Test the quality of the wetland waters using scientific equipment.
- Observe the flora and fauna in the area.
- Explore the links between water quality, human activity and the health of flora and fauna in local wetlands.
- Self-guided gallery exploration through the Museum using the *Wild About Wetlands* Student Activity sheets.

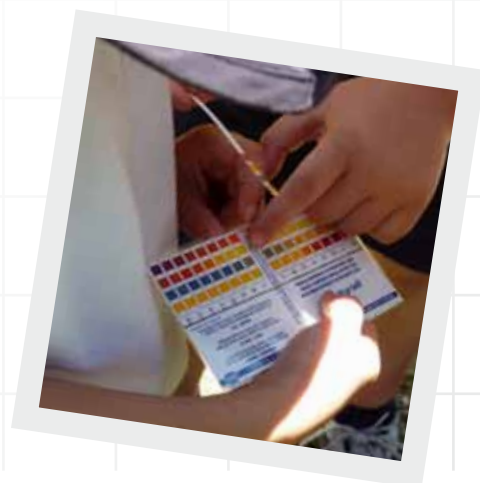
