Decapod Crustacea of Scott and Seringapatam Reefs

Abstract

A total of 40 brachyurans (largely xanthids), 14 paguroids, 1 scyllarid and 1 palinurid was recorded.

Background and discussion

A small collection of decapod crustaceans, largely comprising xanthid crabs and paguroids, was made at Scott and Seringapatam Reefs in 1984. A wide selection of habitats was sampled by diving, reef walking and dredging (see Appendix Table 3).

Although a high proportion of the species collected have not previously been recorded from Western Australian waters, it is not possible to comment on the composition or biogeographic significance of the faunas of these offshore reefs because of the poor state of knowledge of the xanthid and paguroid faunas elsewhere in Western Australia.

A total of 40 brachyuran, 14 paguroid, 1 scyllarid and 1 palinurid species was recorded. The fact that the palinurid *Panulirus versicolor* should occur at Scott Reef but not at the Rowley Shoals is a puzzle and may be attributable to the abundance of large serranid fish, particularly the Potato Cod (*Epinephelus tukula*) which are likely predators of spiny lobsters at the Rowley Shoals. Large serranids were rare at Scott and Seringapatam Reefs.
