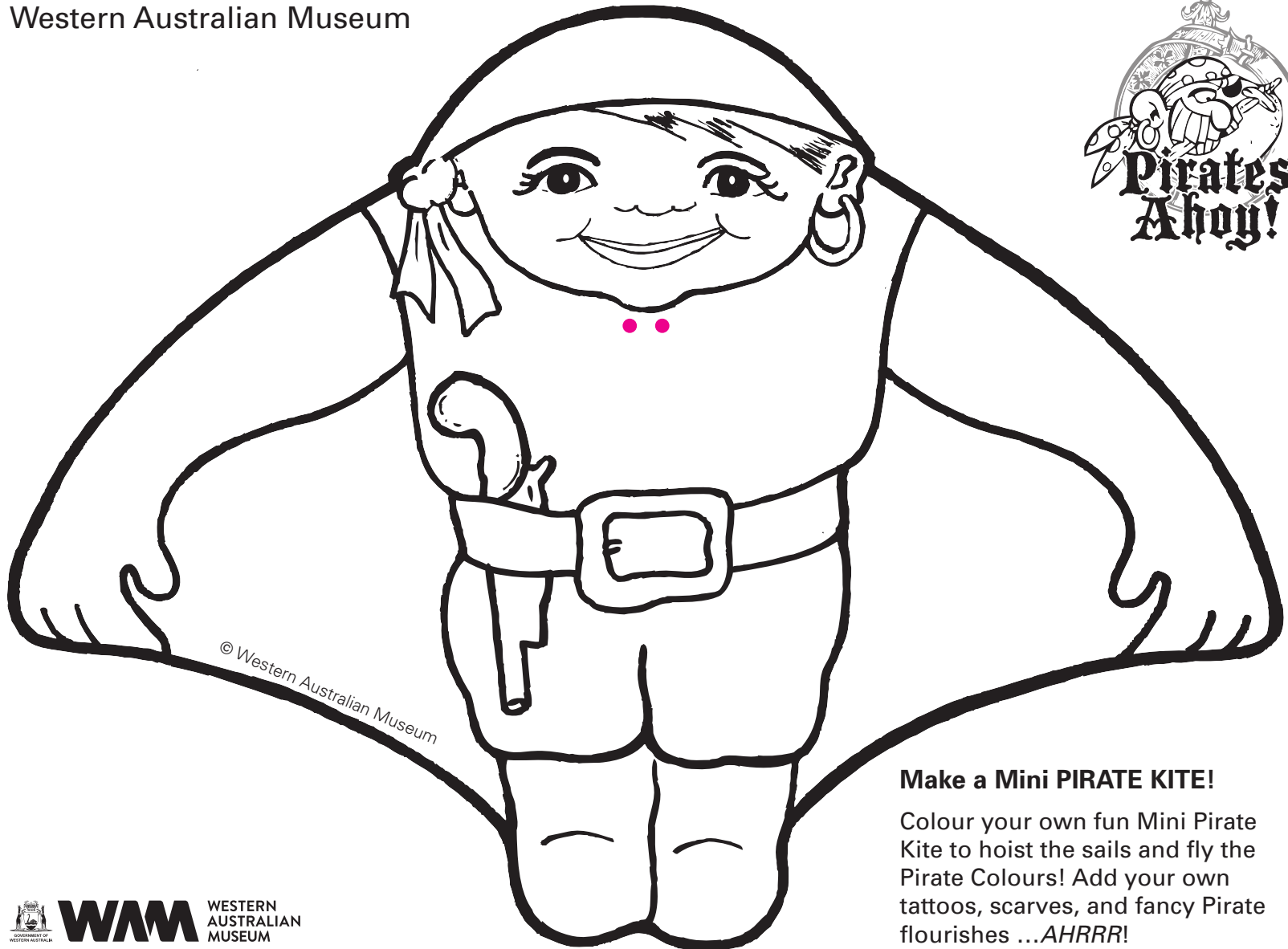


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Make a Mini PIRATE KITE!

Colour your own fun Mini Pirate Kite to hoist the sails and fly the Pirate Colours! Add your own tattoos, scarves, and fancy Pirate flourishes ...**AHRRR!**



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Make a Mini PIRATE KITE!

You will need:

A4 printout of boy or girl mini-kite

Coloured pencils or textas

Biro

Scissors

Sticky tape

3 straws

Cotton reel

Tissue, crepe paper or medium thin plastic garbage bag

Colour in your kite.

Carefully cut it out.

Ask an adult for help to make two small holes on the pink dots using the point of a biro.

Turn your kite over and sticky tape a 20cm straw across the widest part of kite on the back. (Trim the straw if it is too long).

Cut another straw 15cm long and sticky tape on the back, centre from top to bottom.

Tie the cotton thread from the reel through the holes and around the straw, tie off at front.

To make a tail – use thin, long strips of crepe paper, tissue paper or a plastic bag, the longer the better for your tail.

Sticky tape your tail to the bottom on the back of the kite.

Place a straw through your cotton reel to hold it. Your kite is ready to fly!

Be careful you don't let the cotton go out all the way or you will lose your kite!
