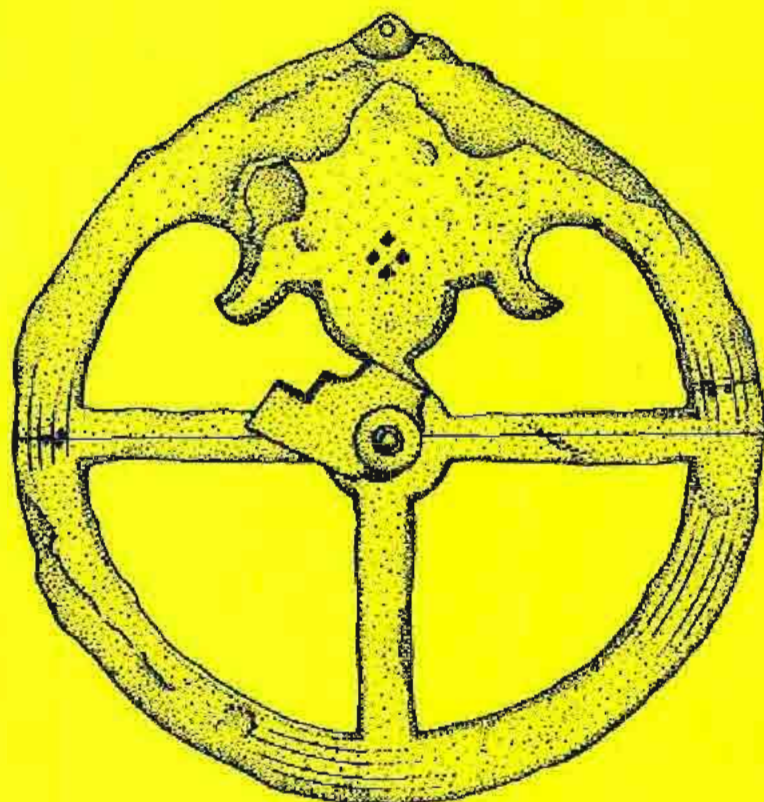

COMPILER'S NOTE

This catalogue has been prepared as a working document in accordance with the requirements of the Australia/Netherlands Committee on Old Dutch Shipwrecks (ANCODS).

It is not a complete catalogue of relics from Dutch East Indiamen wrecked on the Western Australian coast, but rather a catalogue of selected material requested by the Committee for their consideration at a meeting in September 1979 at the Fremantle Maritime Museum, Fremantle, W.A.

Included in the document are brief reports on the current state of progress with regard to excavation, conservation, and research associated with the wrecks of the Batavia, Verquilde Draeck, Zeewijk, and Zuytdorp.

MARITIME ARCHAEOLOGICAL REPORT ON V.O.C. WRECKSITES1. BATAVIA

A total of four seasons of excavation completed on this site. Three-quarters of the wrecksite has been excavated, all that remains is the bow section and a number of iron cannon. At present this site has a low priority for excavation, the main emphasis being on reconstruction and publication.

2. VERGULDE DRAECK

Only one excavation season has been carried out on this site in 1971. The excavation report has been published, and this site now has a high priority for excavation. It is thought that possibly two excavation seasons of about 6-10 weeks should finish this site.

3. ZUYTDORP

At present three days diving have been possible on this site in the past three years. A permanent watchkeeper has been installed on the site and it is hoped to do some work on the site in the future. Any work on this site can only be considered salvage archaeology.

4. ZEEWIJX

The fourth season of work on this site is about to start, funded by the A.R.G.C. This will be the last season on this site and will be the end of the work on this site for the time being.

CONSERVATION REPORT

re: DUTCH ARTIFACTS UNDERGOING TREATMENT

(1) Leather :

All methods which have been previously described in literature for treating waterlogged leather have been tried but results were considered unsatisfactory. Preliminary experiments with freeze drying have been promising and further testing will be carried out when freeze drying unit is delivered. (E.T.A. late August 1979) At present leather is being held in storage awaiting satisfactory treatment.

(2) Elephant Tusks :

These have been treated by vacuum impregnation with PVA . The treatment appears satisfactory but before removing all tusks from solution we have to test one to ensure no cracking will occur. This testing is currently being done and if results are satisfactory treatment should be completed this year.

(3) Iron :

Small iron objects are being treated using hydrogen reduction and caustic washing. This is working well and most of the small iron items have been treated. The large items, such as cannon, are being treated by electrolysis. This method is best available but unfortunately very slow. It may be quite some time before the first treated cannons are completed.

(4) Wood :

Large wooden objects are being treated by PEG impregnation. The same method has been used on small wooden objects but recently we have found better results were obtained using freeze drying methods. A freeze drying unit has been ordered and treatment of small wooden objects will recommence as soon as this unit is commissioned.

(5) Replica Programme

The lack of adequately ventilated work space in which replicas can be made, has forced a suspension of the replication programme. Health problems have already been caused by staff working with plastics in poorly ventilated areas and further risks to health are not acceptable. The making of replicas will recommence when suitable facilities are available but at present this does not appear likely before the move into the Commissariat building by the conservation department.

NUMISMATIC REPORT

Report to ANCODS Committee on progress in treatment,
identification, and recording of coins from VERGULDE
DRAECK, BATAVIA, ZUYTDORP AND ZEEWIJK

VERGULDE DRAECK

At the time of the last meeting of the Committee a selection had been made of a representative collection of coins for the Netherlands Government, the Western Australian Museum and the Australian Government, bearing in mind the wishes of Dr. Van Guelder of the Hague as to special pieces to be included in the Netherlands Collection.

Since then the Netherlands selection has been re-enveloped, checked and packed ready for transmission at the direction of the Committee.

A numismatic history, listing and illustrated catalogue has been published as part of a general work on the Vergulde Draeck by Green, Zuiderbaan, Wilson and Owen of the W.A. Museum Maritime Archaeology Department (BAR Supplementary Series 36(1)1977).

BATAVIA

Treatment and identification of Batavia coins was put aside for a period to allow the completion of work on the Vergulde Draeck.

The last 1800 (approx) Batavia coins are under-going treatment in the Conservation Laboratory and it is now possible to give some idea of the constitution of the total recovered. The following is a list of the information to date which indicates that we have accounted for almost all of one chest of coin and have probably collected some from a second chest.

I would estimate that there is a further two years work to be carried out on the classification and publication of the Batavia coinage.

ZUYDORP

Apart from the slow dribble of coins which turn up from private sources there have been two larger recoveries, one early in the seventies of about 3,500 and one last year of some six thousand which still have to be treated. Almost all are two stuyvers and schellingen of Zeeland of 1711 dating. There is a sprinkling of Ducations of the Spanish Netherlands and some pieces of eight reals of Philip the 5th of Spain. Work on these coins would appear to be a second priority to the Batavia material.

ZEEWIJK

No sizeable quantity of coinage is likely to come from this ship as the whole of the official bullion cargo was salvaged at the time of the wreck. A small collection of coins lost by the Dutch sailors during their nine month residence on Gun Island is slowly coming to hand. Many were picked up by the guano diggers in the eighties of last century and are brought to the Museum from time to time.

Ningaloo Wreck

Although not of Dutch origin a separate report on the Ningaloo coinage is included for the interest of the Committee.

ARTIFACTS FROM THE DUTCH EAST INDIANMAN
ZUYTDORP, WRECKED IN 1712

Introductory Note :

The Wreck of the Zuytdorp is situated at the foot of the Zuytdorp Cliffs, approximately 65km North of the Mouth of Murchison River on the coast of Western Australia. The following artifacts registered in our collection have been recovered from a number of locations associated with the Wreck: the Wrecksite itself; adjoining cliffs and beaches; and areas of land along the cliff top.

These artifacts have been collected over a period of time dating from 1927 to the present. Material with registration numbers ZT 1812 and following, has been recovered since March 1978. Some of the items listed are held in private collections, replicas of the more interesting objects being retained by the Museum. Private ownership of objects is indicated by the suffix PC following the registration number.

A large quantity of coins has been recovered from the wrecksite but since these are still awaiting conservation treatment they are excluded from this catalogue.
