



Make your own standing Stegasaurus

Directions

- 1. Colour in and cut out your Stegasaurus
- 2. Fold in half, join and staple the two flaps under belly.
- 3. Staple the two noses and tails together

The Stegasaurus lived 140 to 150 million years ago during the Jurassic period. Fossil footprints of the Stegasaurus have been found near Broome, Western Australia. The tracks show 5 digits on the front limbs and 3 digits on the back limbs. The plates on the back may have been for defence or for easy recognition between males and females.
