Endangered Animals

Tiger Mask

Colour in your tiger's face and nose section.

Cut around each piece.

Cut along the dotted line in the nose. Match up to straight line by sliding underneath and staple together to form the muzzle.

Cut along the dotted line between the eyes and slot tab A through it. Staple it in place.

Tie a piece of elastic or string at each hole on the sides to hold it over your face.

Tigers are threatened by poaching, loss of habitat and lack of food. Although protected in most areas tigers are still illegally killed for their skins and for traditional Asian medicines.
